As you may know, in response to an application made under the Environmental Bill of Rights, the Ministry of the Environment (MOE) conducted a review of the need for additional legislation and/or provincial policy to protect the Waterloo Moraine.

The review provided a better understanding of the framework in place and activities currently underway to protect the moraine.
